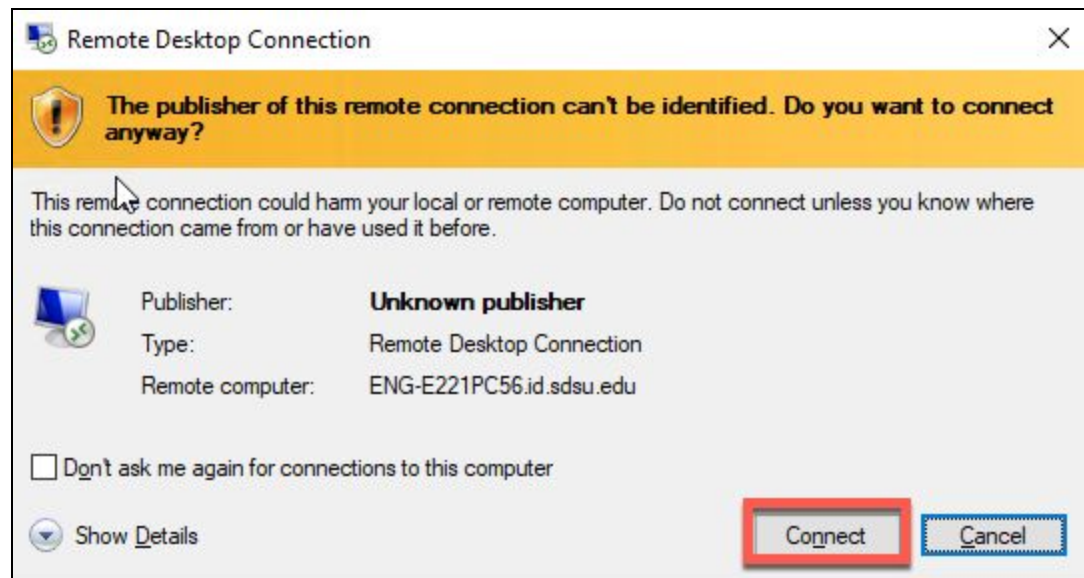


Follow these steps:

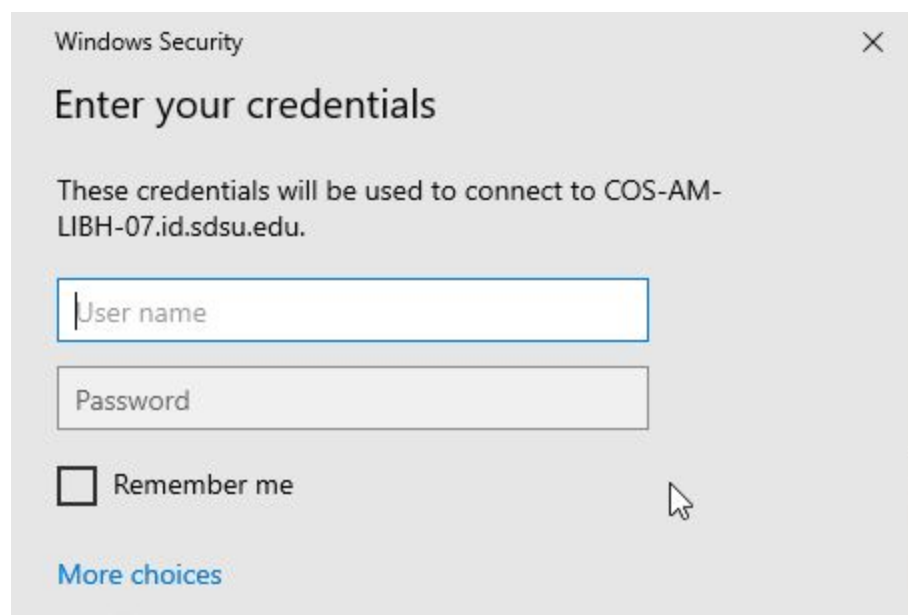
1. Download and open the connection file

6. Allow remote connection by clicking Connect.



7. Enter your SDSUid credentials to log in to the computer and click OK.



8. You are now connected remotely to the computer.
